





Finances

- Grant income
 - MRC Partnership grant 2021 2026
 - Pays for 3 members of core team + collaboration / training activities
- Commercial income
 - Annual licence to for-profit organisations
 - 21/22: 25 companies, ~ £125k
- Other funding
 - STFC Innovations + Global Phasing Ltd, BEIS, ATI, Diamond, Ada Lovelace Centre
 - Covers pipeliner development, machine learning tools
 - Additional projects, made possible by core funding

What is funded

- Training courses
 - Some on MRC grant.
 - Subsidised by commercial income.
- Developers
 - Core team (grant) + 3 (other funding).
 - Support for Matt and community projects (commercial income).

Support for collaborative software development projects.

CCP-EM are keen to support small collaborative software development projects that are of benefit to the wider community and which produce or improve software that can be distributed through the CCP-EM software suite. We can potentially fund / co-fund developer effort in your institution using income arising from licensing of the suite to for-profit organisations. Projects are typically 3 to 6 months in duration, or longer if co-funding is available. We may be able to support studentships or events, provided there is a tangible benefit to the CCP-EM community.
